Jackson, against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.

2. The Grand Jury of said County further charge that before the finding of this indictment John Lee King, alias Johnnie Lee King, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, did receive, conceal, or buy, or aid in concealing, one rifle, of the value of, to-wit, forty-five dollars, the personal property of Reuben S. Jackson, knowing that it was stolen, or having reasonable grounds for believing that it had been stolen, and not having the intent to restore it to the owner,

against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
