We, Dolphus Melton, as Principle, and the undersigned sureties, agree to pay to the State of Alabama the sum of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00), unless the said Dolphus Melton appears at the next term of the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, and from term to term thereafter until discharged by law, to answer a criminal prosecution for the offense of affray.

And we, and each of us, hereby waive all exemptions we may have to any personal property under the Constitution and Laws of the State of Alabama as to the collection of the penalty of this bond.

The condition of the above obligation is such that, whereas the above bound Dolphus Melton was duly convicted in the Circuit Court of Baldwin County on the 17th day of March, 1953, of the above stated offense, and has duly applied for and obtained an appeal from said conviction and sentence to the Court of Appeals for the State of Alabama, and the amount of his appeal bond has been duly and legally fixed at said above stated sum:
