The Grand Jury of said County further charge that before the finding of this indictment GEORGE AYRES, alias GEORGIA AYRES, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, feloniously took and carried away from the store of Emmett Wenzel, to-wit, two pairs of shoes, six cartons of cigarettes, two shirts, two jackets, and one cap, of the value of, to-wit, fifty dollars, the personal property of Emmett Wenzel,

against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
