SECOND: That your complainant and Respondent are husband and wife, having intermarried at Bay Minette, in Baldwin County, Alabama, on or about, to-wit: March 1925; that they lived together as man and wife in Baldwin County, Alabama, until on or about, to-wit: August, 1925.

other dates, the Respondent, Bama Robbins, committed adultery with one Clyde Smith; that said acts of adultery were committed in Baldwin and Monroe Counties, Alabama, without the consent of approval of the Complainant; that the Complainant did not and has not condoned said acts of adultery by Respondent.

PRAYER:

Wherefore, the premises considered, Complainant prays that your monor will take jurisdiction of the cause made by this bill of complaint and by appropriate process make the said Bama Robbins Respondent to this bill fo complaint and require her to plead, answer or demur to the same, within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court and that upon the final hearing of said cause your Honor will grant to your Complainant a decree of absolute divorce from the said Bama Robbins and that such other, further, different or general relief may be granted to your Complainant as your Honor may deem fit and proper and as in duty bound the

Complainant Will ever pray, etc.
