JONES, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, in obtaining merchandise, property, or gasoline, things of value, or in payment of an obligation to Sam Ard, Jr., whereby additional credit was obtained, made, drew, uttered, or delivered a check for the payment of three hundred thirty-five and 71/100 (\$335.71) dollars upon the Baldwin County Bank, knowing at the time of such making, drawing, uttering or delivery that the maker or drawer had not sufficient funds in, or credit with such bank, for the payment in full of such check upon its due presentation,

against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
