2. The Grand Jury of said County further charge that before the finding of this indictment JOHNNY HAYES, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, feloniously took and carried away from the Loxley Junior High School house, to-wit, money in about the amount of ten dollars in lawful United States money, the denominations of said money and a further description of the amount of said money being unknown to the Grand Jury, of the value of, to-wit, ten dollars, the personal property of the Baldwin County Board of Education, in the custody of Samuel Gates,

against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
