The Grand Jury of said County further charge that before the finding of this indictment WILLIAM HUGGINS, JR., whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, feloniously took and carried away from the Robertsdale High School house, to-wit, thirty boxes of candy, of the value of, to-wit, thirty dollars, the personal property of the Baldwin County Board of Education, in the custody of C. F. Taylor,

against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
