The Grand Jury of said County charge that before the finding of this indictment THOMAS EDWARD KITTRELL, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, with intent to steal, broke into and entered the store or building of Maurice E. Olen and Harry L. Olen, known as Olen Department Stores in Bay Minette, Alabama, in which goods, wares, merchandise, or clothing, things of value, were kept for sale or deposit, against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.

2. The Grand Jury of said County further charge that before the finding of this indictment THOMAS EDWARD KITTRELL, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, feloniously took and carried away, to-wit, seventeen shirts, one pair of trousers, one sweater, four pairs of socks, and three slip-over shirts, of the aggregate value of, to-wit, sixty-nine dollars, the personal property of Maurice E. Olen and Harry L. Olen,

against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
