J. Ballard, known as Home Tire and Radio Service, in which goods, wares, merchandise, or radios, things of value, were kept for use, sale, or deposit, against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.

2. The Grand Jury of said county further charge that before the finding of this indictment THOMAS EDWARD KITTRELL, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, feloniously took and carried away one Zenith radio, of the value of, to-wit, forty dollars, the personal property of L. J. Ballard, and one Zenith radio, of the value of, to-wit, thirty-five dollars, the personal property of Newton Reid,

against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
