5. The Court charges the jury that the jury must believe beyond a reasonable doubt, that the Defendant got the skill saw into his hands or actual possession before they convict him of larceny.

On English has

1. The Court charges the jury that every man comes into the Court presumed to be innocent and that the State must prove beyond a reasonable doubt that the Defendant is guilty of the crime for which he is charged.

2. The Court charges the jury that it is the burden of the State to prove beyond a reasonable doubt that the Defendant is guilty of the crime for which he is charged.

3. The Court charges the jury that if there is a reasonable doubt in a jurors mind as to the innocence of the Defendant then the Defendant cannot be found guilty of the crime for which he is charged.

4. The Court charges the jury that if any witness testifying has been impeached, then the jury may disregard the entire testimony of such witness, unless it be corroborated by other testimony not so impeached, and if after weighing all the testimony, and according to each part of it such weight as it is entitled, you are not convinced beyond all reasonable doubt that the Defendant was present at the time of the alleged larceny, then you should find the Defendant not guilty.


