The Grand Jury of said County further charge that before the finding of this indictment Ocie Patterson, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, feloniously took and carried away from a dwelling house four hundred dollars (\$400.00), the denomination and further description of the money being unknown to the Grand Jury, the personal property of Mrs Hubart Hinote,

against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.


