**Pensacola Youth
Dies Of Injuries**

A 10-year-old Pensacola boy, critically injured in an auto-bicycle collision at Silverhill Friday night, died Saturday morning at a local hospital.

The young Pensacolan, Carlos Randolph Sansing, died at 9:25 a.m. of severe head and leg injuries, according to attendants at the hospital in Mobile.

Highway Patrolmen R. E. Etheridge and W. W. Jeffries said young Sansing was hit by the auto when he attempted to pull his bicycle onto Highway 104 near the city limits of Silverhill.

Highway patrolmen said the driver of the auto, Elbert Ruel Mills, 28, Fairhope, would be charged with manslaughter.

Death of the boy brought the highway fatality toll in Baldwin County to eight for this year.

Young Sansing reportedly was visiting relatives in Silverhill. His mother is Mrs. Mary Lucille Sansing of Pensacola.

**Reds Free Prisoners;
Seek Adenauer Defeat**

BERLIN—(AP)—Russia turned the clock further back Saturday on the Sovietization of East Germany. Hundreds of prisoners were freed and some more Communist policies were scrapped in the Kremlin's occupation zone.

Red spokesmen said the big objective was to defeat West Germany's pro-American chancellor, Konrad Adenauer, who is up for re-election this Summer, and to prepare for the unification of Germany.
