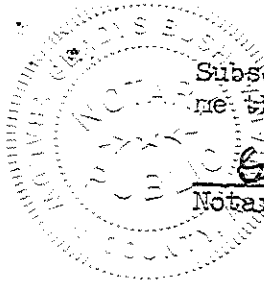

Green, be removed, and that said minor be vested with the right to contract, sue and be sued, to buy, sell and convey real estate, and to do and perform all acts which said minor could lawfully do on her becoming the age of twenty one years.
