that
in said county and within twelve months before the commencement of this prosecution he did engage in taking, killing, or capturing commercial or non-game fish from the public impounded waters and navigable streams of the State of Alabama by using in such commercial fishing operations hoop and fyke nets, seines, gill nets, trammel nets, setlines, trotlines, or snaglines and lawful fishtraps, without marking their location by bouys or floats and identifying such nets and lines by showing the license number in plain figures upon the bouys or floats, and without at least one such bouy bearing the name and address of the said J.T. Hall,

contrary to law and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
