Count 1: THE STATE vs. LLOYD McCREARY

The State of Alabama, by its Solicitor, complains of LLOYD McCREARY

that

in said county and within twelve months before the commencement of this prosecution he did give away, sell, serve, or drink alcoholic or malt or brewed beverages in a cafe, lunchroom, restaurant, hotel dining room or other public place on Sunday, contrary to law and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.

Count 1: The State of Alabama, by its Solicitor, complains of LLOYD McCREARY that in said county and within twelve months before the commencement of this prosecution he did, as the proprietor, keeper, or operator of a cafe, lunchroom, restaurant, hotel dining room, or other public place, knowingly permit a person to give away, sell, serve or drink alcoholic or malt or brewed beverages on the premises of such cafe, lunchroom, restaurant, hotel dining room, or other public place on Sunday,

contrary to law and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
