(Decree) Defendant on his plea of guilty fined \$50.00

that the Defendant pay the fine and costs in this case  
on or before December 21st, 1955.

It appearing to the Court that the said defendant

of Violating prohibition law, and was sentenced to  
Pay a fine of \$50.00 and costs and given probation for a period  
of one year.  
and the said defendant agreed to pay the fine and costs  
by December 21st, 1955. The  
said defendant, having failed to pay the said fine and  
costs or to confess judgment for the same as required by  
law and having failed to appear before this Court, it is  
therefore,

Ordered, Adjudged and Decreed that you forthwith  
arrest the defendant, Albert Joiner,  
and bring him before me to be sentenced as required by law.

THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATION IS SUCH, That whereas, the above bounden ALBERT JOINER, was, on the 5th day of July, 1945, convicted in the County, of the offense VIOLATING PROHIBITION LAW

and by the judgment of said Court sentenced to ~~One hundred fifty dollar (\$150.00) fine~~ or 90 days in Jail.

And, whereas, the said ALBERT JOINER

has this day prayed an appeal from said judgment to the Circuit Court of said County:

Now, if the said ALBERT JOINER shall appear at the next term of the Circuit Court, and from term to term thereafter until discharged, and abide by and perform whatever sentence may be adjudged in said Court against him, then the above obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect.
