And that Your Honor forthwith set same down for hearing and trial, not less than three days from the date of the Solicitor filing said charge; and that on said date of hearing Your Honor hear and determine your petitioners' plea of guilty, and fix your petitioners' punishment and forthwith sentence your petitioners to the penitentiary of the State of Alabama. And we pray for general relief.
