

BILL OF COMPLAINT

TO THE HONORABLE F. W. HARE, JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA IN CHANCERY SITTING:

PART ONE

Your Complainant, Joseph Pollitz, respectfully shows that he is over the age of 21 years and a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, residing at Foley, therein and that the Respondent, Frank Lewak is also over the age of 21 years and a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, residing at Foley therein.

PART TWO

1. Your Complainant further avers and shows to the Court that prior to January 26, 1942, he was the owner of and in possession of the following described real estate in Baldwin County, Alabama, to-wit:

Lots numbered eight (8), nine (9) and ten (10) in Block forty-one (41) in Foley, Alabama, being a part of a subdivision of Sections twenty-eight (28) and twenty-nine (29) in Township seven (7) South, Range four (4) East.

2. That on said 26th day of January, 1942, your complainant made, executed and delivered to the Respondent, Frank Lewak, a Warranty Deed conveying said above described real estate to the said Frank Lewak which said deed is recorded in the office of the Judge of Probate of Baldwin County, Alabama, in Deed Book 76 NS at Pages 570 and 571 thereof.

3. That your Complainant, the grantor in said deed, hereby elects to declare the same void and takes this proceeding in equity to annul such conveyance and avers that the sole and only consideration for said conveyance was the promise of the Respondent, Frank Lewak, the grantee in said deed, to support your Complainant during his life.
