APPLICATION FOR EXTRADITION

THE STATE OF ALABAMA BALDWIN COUNTY

To His Excellency, JAMES E. FOLSOM, Governor of the State of Alabama:

The undersigned Kenneth Cooper, Solicitor of 28th Judicial Circuit (Baldwin County) respectfully represents unto your Excellency:

That one John Starling is charged in the Justice of Peace Court of Hon T.C. Hand with the offense of Forgery, 1st Degree (as shown by the certified copy of affidavit

(indictment, information and affidavit filed, or complaint made to the magistrate)

accompanying this petition), alleged to have been committed on, to-wit, November 27th, 1954 at Bay Minette, Alabama in the County of Baldwin

in the State of Alabama, in that the said John Starling, with intent to injure or defraud, did alter, forge, or counterfeit a certain check, which was in substance as follows:

The Bank of Fairhope No. 11-27-1954
Pay To The Fairhope, Alabama.
Order Of John Starling \$20 75
Twenty and 75/100 Dollars

or with intent to injure or defraud, did alter, forge, or counterfeit and publish as true the said altered, forged, or counterfeited check, knowing the same to be so altered, forged or counterfeited. R.T. Knowles

That said John Starling is now a fugitive from justice in this State and is believed to have taken refuge in the State of Delaware and is at the present time in or near New Castle in that State.

That it is necessary for the ends of justice that said fugitive should be returned to the State of Alabama; that this petition is made in furtherance of the ends of public justice and not for any private claim whatever, or for the collection or enforcement of a debt, or for any other improper purpose.

Your petitioner suggest to your Excellency the name of Taylor Wilkins, R.J. Granger and J.D. Horn, who resides at Bay Minette, Alabama, and who has no private or personal interest in the apprehension of said fugitive, as a suitable person to be commissioned as the agent of the State in said extradition.

Your petitioner hereby certifies that he has investigated the facts in the above-named case, that the testimony in said case is accessible, and that in his opinion a conviction will be had if said case is brought to trial.
