2. The Grand Jury of said County further charge that before the finding of this indictment Curtis Reed feloniously took a watch of the value of Ten Dollars and Fifty-eight Dollars in lawful money of the United States of America, consisting of One Twenty Dollar bill, three Ten Dollar bills and eight One Dollar bills, the property of Harry Nelson, from his person and against his will, by violence to his person or by putting him in such fear as unwillingly to part with the same,

against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
