The Grand Jury of said County further charge that before the finding of this indictment and after the first day of July, 1935, Norman Ramsey, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, in the daytime, with intent to steal, broke into and entered the dwelling house or other house or building of Robert J. Catrett, which was at the time unoccupied,

against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
