

Testimony of Roxie Hendrix:

My name is Roxie Hendrix. I am over twenty-one years of age and reside at Loxley, Baldwin County, Alabama. I have lived in Baldwin County, Alabama my entire life. Henry D. Hendrix is my husband and he is over the age of twenty-one years and was over the age of twenty-one years at the time of our marriage; his place of residence is unknown and I cannot locate his place of residence. I have exercised reasonable diligence in endeavoring to locate the said Henry D. Hendrix. I have tried to locate him through inquiries of other person whom I thought might know and have continuously done this for more than one years time before filing this bill for divorce.

Henry D. Hendrix threatened to kill me and at one time struck me on the shoulder; he often threatened to knock my brains out; he was high tempered and nervous. We were married on June 28th, 1926 and lived together until July 15th, 1926, at which time we separated on account of his mean treatment of me; he struck me with his fist; he was constantly making threats to kill me and from the threats made and the fact that he struck me my health and life was endangered and from the said threats I feared great body harm which would endanger my life and health.
