My name is Willie Mae "Billie" Douglas. I am 30 years of age. I live at 14 Cotton Mill Village, Mobile County, Prichard, Ala, with my sister.

On the night of August 30, 1943, I went out with my boy friend whoes first name is Francis and whoes last name I do not know. We came in about one O'clock and I had just undressed and gone to bed and about 1:30 A.m. on the same night, Helen Slay came to my sisters house where I am staying and ask me to come and go with her that she had me a boy friend. I got up and dressed and went out to the car and there were two men waiting for us. I do not know their names and I had never seen them before. Helen and here boy friend was in the back seat and me and my boy friend was in the front seat. We drove over to the Shady Diamond Inn and got us something to eat and drink. After we finished eating and drinking we danced a little while. I guess we stayed at the Shady Diamond Inn about an hour. When we left the Shady Diamond Inn, we drove across the bay bridge beyond the Spanish Fort. We drove on down the highway to a side road and turned off thn the side road and we went just a little ways on the side road and stopped. My friend and I were sitting in the front seat. Helen Slays boy friend got out of the car and took the cigarett which he was smoking and stuck it up on a tree. He then said that he was going to try his gun and see if it would shoot. My boy friend and I told him not to talk like that because we didn't like to hear people talk about shooting. Helen then got out of the car and went around the car to the left hand side where boy friend was standing. Helen then told me boy friend to "Step out Buddy" she said this two or three time and then her boy friend said "Yes, step out." So my boy friend stepped out of the car and they said to him "stand Still". Helen Slay and her boy friend searched my boy friend and I saw them take his pocket book from him and I guess they took all of this belongings. My boy friend said "What is all this bout". They told him to "Keep Quite". They then told my boy friend to leave the key in the car and he told them that the key was alread in the car. They found another key in his pocket and he told them that was the key to his room and he would have to have it. They said "Alright I'll give it back to you. They told him to walk up the road so he began to walk up the road. Then the boy that was with Helen Slay cranked up the car and Helen, herx boy friend and I drove off. I told them to let me out and they said they were going to bring me back to Prichard. They both told me "Not to talk". We got back to my sisters house in the Village somewhere around xxx quarter of four on the same morning.

I make this statement freely and voluntarily without any threats being made to me or any rewards offered to me on this the 3rd day of SEPT., 1943.


