The court charges the Jury that if they find from the evidence that any witness has made contradictory statements as to material facts in this case or any of such facts, the Jury may look to these contradictory statements in order to determine what credence they will give to the testimony of such witnesses.

Swern Stare Judge

The court charges the Jury that proof of contradictory statements or declarations on a material point made by any witness may be such to raise a reasonable doubt in the minds of the Jury as to the truth of the testimony of such witness.

Bring Judge

The court charges the Jury that the defendant is authorized under the Statute to testify in his own behalf and the Jury have a right to give full credit to his statements.

Given Hare Judge

The court charges the Jury that the burden is upon the State and it is the duty of the State to show beyond a reasonable doubt and to the exclusion of every other reasonable hypothesis every circumstance to show that the defendant is guilty; and unless the State has done that in this case it is your duty, Gentlemen of the Jury, to render a verdict of not guilty.

Given FM Hares Judge 3. The court charges the Jury that good character itself is part of the evidence in this case and if the Jury upon a consideration of all the evidence have a reasonable doubt growing out of any part of the evidence, the Jury will give the defendant the benefit of such doubt and acquit him.

Geor FN Harl Julyl The court charges the Jury that the burden is on the State to convince you of defendant's guilt to the exclusion of every reasonable doubt and by evidence that overcomes the presumption of fact that the law surrounds the defendant with, that he is innocent of crime.

Gren FM. Harl Judge

The court charges the Jury that the legal presumption of innocence is to be regarded by the Jury in every case as a matter of evidence, to the benefit of which the accused is entitled; and, as a matter of evidence it attends the accused until his guilt is by the evidence placed beyond a reasonable doubt.

Diver Hare Judgo

The court charges the Jury that the innocence of the defendant is presumed until his guilt is established by the evidence in all the material aspects of the case beyond a reasonable doubt, to a moral certainty, and it may also be said that evidence of guilt must be strong and cogent, and, unless it is so strong and cogent as to show that defendant, is fuilty to a moral certainty, defendant should be acquitted.

The court charges the Jury that if they believe from the evidence in this case that any witness has willfully and corruptly sworn falsely as to any material fact in this case you may in your discretion disregard the testimony of such witness entirely.
