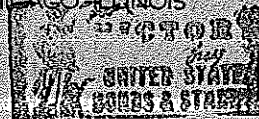

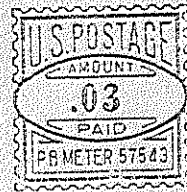

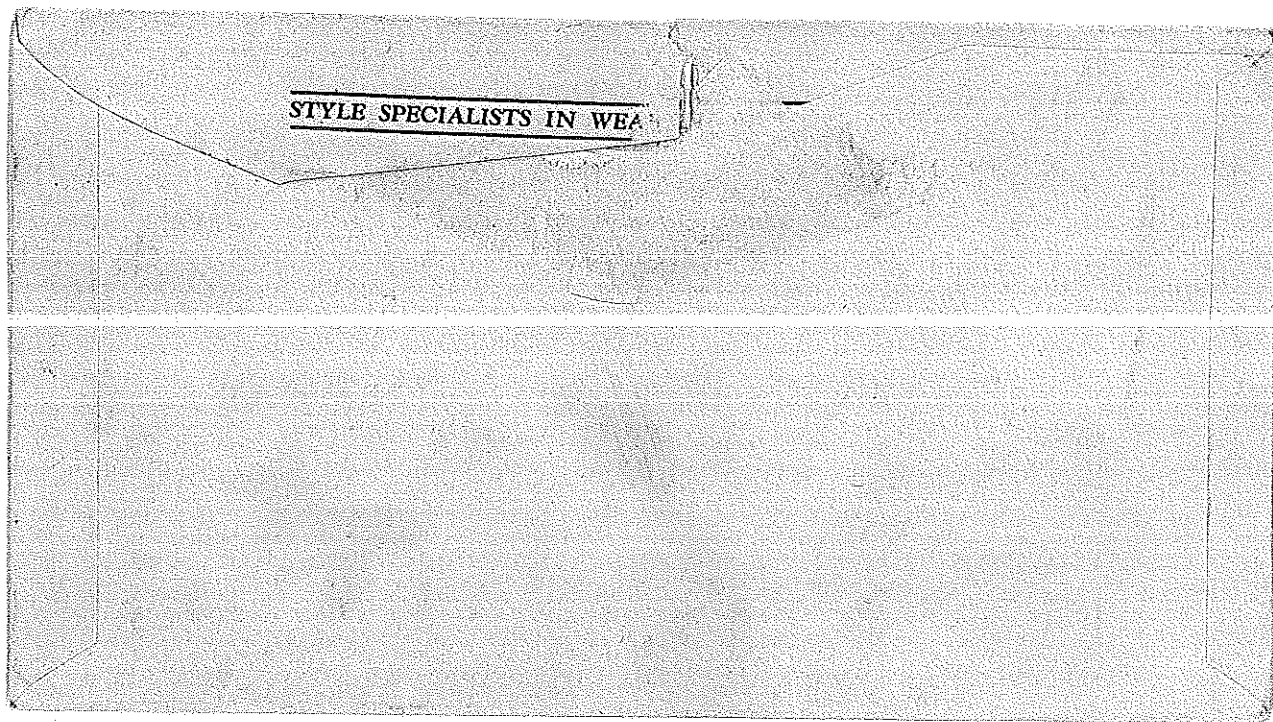

IT COSTS MONEY TO WRITE LETTERS


I don't like to write letters asking for money, and you certainly don't like to receive them. Isn't that reason enough why we should get together and cut out this unnecessary correspondence?

If I can tell you everything you want to know in this letter, there should be no need for another one, and that is what I will try to do.

1. I have your check that was returned unpaid, right here before me; it was returned because you didn't have the money on deposit to pay the check when it arrived.
2. Possibly you made another deposit the next day and didn't know the check was returned, but it was returned and we had to pay our bank the amount of the check and take it back.
3. Your bank probably charged you 25 cents to pay for their trouble in returning the check - at least most banks are doing that now.
4. ~~It cost us more than 50 cents to handle the return of your check and we don't have our money yet. Does it seem fair for us to stand that expense?~~
5. It will only cost you a few cents to send us a money order in exchange for the check. Won't you do that for us?
6. After all, it wasn't our fault that the check was returned, and we know you don't want us to pay out any more money because of it.

Don't bother to write a letter, just mail us a money-order with this letter. If you want the old check back, please enclose an envelope with your address on it.
