convicted in the Justice Court, Baldwin County, of the offense Driving a motor vehicle upon the highways of the State of Alabama while under the influence of intoxicating liquors or narcotic drugs

and by the judgment of said Court sentenced to Pay a fine of One Hundred Dollars & Costs or to serve six months in Baldwin County jail

And, whereas, the said Marvell Lee Hobbs

has this day prayed an appeal from said judgment to the Circuit Court of said County:

Now, if the said Marvell Lee Hobbs shall appear at the next term of the Circuit Court, and from term to term thereafter until discharged, and abide by and perform whatever sentence may be adjudged in said Court against him, then the above obligation to be void; otherwise to remain in full force and effect.
