
PLEA TO JURISDICTION

Comes the Defendant, by his Attorney, and for plea in this cause says: This Court has no jurisdiction of this Defendant or of this offense for the following separate and several reasons, to-wit:

1. This Court has no jurisdiction of this Defendant because the alleged judgment of conviction made by Chas. C. Hand, Justice of Peace, Precinct 4, Baldwin County, Alabama, on October 21, 1944, is void because the said Justice of Peace had no jurisdiction of the said offense which was an affray in which a weapon was used.

2. This Court has no jurisdiction of this cause of action because it was an offense in which a stick or other weapon was used, because of which Chas. C. Hand, Justice of Peace, Precinct 4, Baldwin County, Alabama, had no jurisdiction of the said offense and the alleged judgment of conviction rendered by him on October 21, 1944 is void.

All of which this Defendant is ready to verify and prays that this Court should take no further jurisdiction or cognizance of the said offense and that he be discharged.
