COURT 3

The Grand Jury of said County further charge that before the finding of this indictment, Thomas M. Renka, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, feloniously took and carried away about one Hundred and Eighty Dollars, of the lawful currency of the United States of America, the exact amount and denomination of which are to the Grand Jury unknown, of the value of One Hundred and Eighty Dollars, the personal property of Baldwin County High School,

against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
