

The Defendant is not ready for trial on account of the absence of Elizabeth Watson, a witness summoned for the defendant, who is absent without the procurement of consent of the defendant, and who if present would testify as follows:

That on or about the 9th day of June, 1945, she was living in Mobile, Alabama; that Mrs. R. E. Box called her to go on a party as the date of one Nappy Coker, a man whom she had never met; that she agreed to go and they came by her house and picked her up; that eight persons, being four men and four women went together to Fairhope in one automobile. That some one had whiskey in the car and every one in the party was drinking with the exception of Mr. R. E. Box. That they took several drinks on the way to Fairhope; when the party arrived at Fairhope they went to the second floor of the Casino building where they spent more than an hour drinking and dancing. That they carried their whiskey to the Casino with them and every one except Mr. R. E. Box engaged in drinking at that place. That finally the whole party left the Casino and went down to the beach where they all went out into the water; that both Ruth Morrow and William Howard Smith had been drinking with the party and both went along into the water with the party; that her date, Nappy Coker, became sick and left the crowd, but that she remained with the crowd until they all left the water; that besides their party, there were a considerable number of other people in the water in and around them; that they stayed in the water for a considerable length of time, during all of which time she was in close proximity to the defendant and Ruth Morfow, and numerous other persons were close to them; that she came out of the water along with them and that during all the time she was in the water the said Ruth Morrow made no outcry or any call for help; that nothing occurred to
