

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The Grand Jury of said County further charges that before the finding of this indictment Morris H. Mack, whose name to the Grand Jury is otherwise unknown, unlawfully, but without malice, or the intention to kill, killed John Lands, whose name to the Grand Jury is otherwise unknown, by negligently parking a motor vehicle on a highway in Baldwin County, Alabama, thereby causing an automobile in which John Lands was riding to collide with the said negligently parked motor vehicle and causing the death of John Lands,

against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.


