Now comes your Complainant, HELEN SNOWDEN, and humbly complaining against the Respondent, CHARLEY SNOWDEN, respectfully represents and shows - unto your Honor and this Honorable Court as follows:

1.

That the Complainant and the Respondent are both over the age of twenty-one and residents of Baldwin County, Alabama;

2.

That the Complainant and the Respondent were married at Pensacola, Florida, on December 9, 1939, and lived together as husband and wife, in Baldwin County, Alabama, until in July, 1941;

3.

That on to-wit: in July, 1941, the Respondent threatened, cursed and abused the Complainant and threatened to do violence to her person; that the conduct of the Respondent was such as to cause the Respondent every reasonable apprehension to believe and she did actually believe that if she continued to live with him he would do violence to her person, which would necessarily endanger her life and health.

PRAYER FOR PROCESS

Wherefore, the premises considered, your Complainant prays that your Honor will by proper process, make the said CHARLEY SNOWDEN party respondent to this Bill of Complaint, requiring him to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court.

Complainant further prays that upon a final hearing hereof, your Honor will grant unto her an absolute decree of divorce, forever barring the bonds of matrimony existing between her and the Respondent; and that your Honor will give and grant unto her such other, further, different and general relief as she may be in equity and good conscience entitled to receive, and as in duty bound she will ever pray.
