

Comes the defendant Jack Arnold and moves the Court to set aside the verdict of the jury and the sentence of the court and grant the defendant a new trial assigning the following separate and several grounds;

1. The verdict of the jury was against the weight of the evidence.
2. The verdict of the jury was against the preponderance of the evidence.
3. The Court erred in refusing to give the general charge at the request of the defendant.
4. The Court erred in over ruling defendants motion for a directed verdict of acquittal.
5. From all of the evidence in the case it does not appear that the defendant was guilty of the crime of Grand Larceny.
6. The verdict of the jury is based on conjecture, surmise or suspicion.
7. The defendant was prejudiced, irreparably by the argument of the solicitor in the statement "all negroes will steal."
8. The verdict of the jury was based on prejudice aroused by the argument of the solicitor.


Gentlemen: Re: State vs. Jack Arnold

No item of cost will be allowed, not provided for in Section 3739 of the Code of 1923, special or local laws to the contrary notwithstanding.

"The orders, judgments and decrees, entered upon the minutes of the court are parts of the record of the causes to which they pertain, and need not be copied into the final record. If so copied, no fee will be allowed therefor."

When special solicitor is appointed, a certified copy of judgment making appointment, must accompany the cost bills. Magistrate and Constables fees not to both exceed five dollars. No fees allowed witnesses before committing magistrate.

The names of all witnesses for whom the clerk issued a subpoena and on whom the sheriff served a subpoena must be shown regardless of whether such witnesses proved attendance or not.
