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

My name is A. M. Troyer. I am a resident of Fairhope, Baldwin County, Alabama, and am the husband of Elva D. Troyer, the Complainant in this cause. I, at the request of my wife, made and caused to be made such an inquiry to ascertain and determine the ages and addresses of the Respondents in this cause, and they were found to be as set out in the Original $^{\mathrm{B}}$ ill. I also made and caused to be made a search and inquiry to find out the present address of Fred Evans, Carrie McNulty, and James B. Peck, but was unable to find out the same; but from such information obtainable, I am satisfied that they are non-residents of the State of Alabama, and are over twenty-one years of age. I also made and had made search and inquiry as to the heirs of fred Harford and John D. Ragland, but was unable to find them out, but from such imformation obtainable, I am satisfied that they are non-residents of the State of Alabama, and are over twentyone years of age. On February 3rd, 1925, Mrs. Elva D. Troyer, my wife, purchased the land described in this cause, that is, the Southwest quarter of the Mortheast quarter of Section 31, Township
