19. The Court charges the jury that although there may be no probability of the innocence of the defendant, yet, if there is in the minds of the jury a reasonable doubt of his guilt, it is the duty of the jury to give him the benefit of the doubt and acquit him.

Biren Jarlye Judge



18. The Court charges the jury that you are not authorized to find a verdict of guilty on the testimony of a single witness, if you have a reasonable doubt of the truth of his statement.

15. The Court charges the jury that if a conviction in this case depends upon the testimony of a single witness; and if the jury have a reasonable doubt as to the truthfulness of the testimony of such witness, they cannot convict the defendant.

10. The Court charges the jury that the innocence of defendant is presumed until *** guilt is established by the evidence in all the material aspects of the case beyond a reasonable doubt, to a moral certainty, and it may also be said that evidence of guilt must be strong and cogent, and, unless it is so strong and cogent as to show that defendant is guilty to a moral certainty, defendant should be acquitted.

Grien Strang

11. The Court charges the jury that the defendant enters into this trial with a presumption of innocence, and this is a fact in the case, which must be considered with all the evidence, and should not be disregarded.

2. The Court charges the jury that if there is one single fact proved to the satisfaction of the jury which is inconsistent with the defendant's guilt, this is sufficient to raise a reasonable doubt, and the jury should acquit

Green gyfale 12. The Court charges the jury that there is a legal presumption of innocence which is to be regarded as a matter of evidence by the jury to the benefit of which the accused is entitled, and as a matter of evidence it attends the defendant until his guilt is, by the evidence, placed beyond a reasonable doubt.

Arang district

13. The Court charges the jury that the humane provision of the law is that every one charged with crime is presumed to be innocent, and this presumption goes with him as a shield for his protection throughout the entire trial until the state removes it by satisfying evidence of such character as to establish his guilt to a moral certainty.

Grand Golge

1. The Court charges the jury that, if the jury, upon considering all the evidence, have a reasonable doubt about the defendant's guilt, arising out of any part of the evidence, they should find him not guilty.

Grand Jake

7. The Court charges the jury that the burden is upon the state, and it is the duty of the state to show, beyond a reasonable doubt and to the exclusion of every other reasonable hypothesis every circumstance necessary to show that the defendant is guilty; and, unless the state has done that in this case, it is your duty, gentlemen of the jury, to render a verdict of not guilty.

Line Jakons

5. The Court charges the jury that defendant cannot be convicted in this case unless each and every juror is not only reasonably satisfied from the evidence of defendant's guilt, but if satisfied from the evidence, and the evidence alone, beyond all reasonable doubt, and to a moral certainty, of his guilt.

Gran Surfer

8. The Court charges the jury that the burden is on the state to convince you of defendant's guilt to the exclusion of every reasonable doubt, and by evidence that overcomes the presumption of fact, that the law surrounds the defendant with, that he is innocent of crime.

Grish Jahren Jahren

9. The Court charges the jury that the legal presumption of innocence is to be regarded by the jury in every case as a matter of evidence, to the benefit of which the accused is entitled; and, as a matter of evidence, it attends the accused until his guilt is, by the evidence, placed beyond a reasonable doubt.

Jury must find the defendant not guilty "unless the evidence against him should be such as to exclude to amoral certainty every hypothesis but that of his guilt of the offense imputed to him," and that "evidence for the state should be so convincing as to lead the minds of the jury to the conclusion that the accused cannot be guiltless," are but strong expressions of the full measure of proof which the law exacts before it will sanction a conviction of a criminal offense, all of which only means that the jury must be convinced beyond a reasonable doubt.

6. The Court charges the jury that if there is, from the evidence, a reasonable probability of defendant's innocence, the jury should acquit the defendant.
