The condition of the above obligation is such that, on the 17 day of July,  
19 48, N. E. Grees a Justice of the Peace in and for said State and County,  
rendered a judgment in favor of the said State of Alabama  
against the said Mason Lewis for the sum of

50 dollars, debt, and \$7.25 cost dollars, costs, from which judgment the said Mason Lewis  
has applied for and obtained an appeal to the July
