Memorandum for Record:

Agreement has been reached between Taylor Wilkins, Sheriff of Baldwin County, and Kenneth Cooper, Circuit Solicitor, 28th Judicial Circuit, that William James Orr, now being held in Baldwin County jail awaiting indictment by next Grand Jury for forgery, will be released to Mr. Rube Cullifer for return to Columbus, Ga., for trial there. Mr. Cullifer will post a \$500.00 cash bond, in addition to having paid the above account, and he gives assurance that upon release by the Georgia authorities, if he is given a prison term, William James Orr will be returned to the Baldwin County Sheriff, and upon delivery of said William James Orr he, Mr. Cullifer, will be released of the \$500.00 bond which is being posted. The hold-over bond will be posted by Mr. Cullifer with the Georgia authorities for Orr.

If William James Orr should become deceased, Mr. Cullifer will be released of his liabilities on the bond posted.
