This cause coming on to be heard upon the petition of Dent F. Green, Superintendent of Banks, for the State of Alabama, praying for authority to transfer the assets of the Loxley State Bank, now in liquidation, to the Farmers State Bank of Loxley as liquidating agent for the purpose of liquidation and it appearing that due notice of said petition has been given to the officers of the said Loxley State Bank who have waived further notice thereof and it further appearing to the Court that the offer of the Farmers State Bank is just and reasonable and to the interest of the depositors and creditors of the Loxley State Bank; and said petition and the exhibits thereto attached having been carefully considered and the Court being of the opinion that said petition should be granted:

It is therefore, ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the petitioner, the Superintendent of Banks be, and he hereby is authorized andempowered to accept the proposed offer and to execute proper instruments, conveying to the Farmers State Bank of Loxley the Bank Building and fixtures and to said Bank as liquidating Agent all of the remaining assets of the Loxley State Bank in consideration of the said Farmers State Bank binding itself to act as liquidating agent without compensation, to assume all obligations and deposits of the Loxley State Bank, to collect as far as possible all assets of said Bank and apply same to the repayment to itself all of the debts and obligations so assumed, and, after paying all costs and expenses of said liquidation including necessary court costs, counsel fees and other expenses of collection, any balance remaining to be divided among the stockholders of the Loxley State Bank in proportion to their respective holdings of stock.

It is further ordered that this cause be retained upon the docket for such further orders and decrees as may from time to time become necessary in the premises.

TO THE HONORABLE FRANCES W. HARE, JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA: SITTING IN EQUITY:

of Alabama and by this his petition respectfully shows:

FIRST: That on February 21st, 1930, the Loxley State Bank, a Bank organized under the laws of Alabama and doing business at Loxley, Alabama, pursuant to and by authority of the unanimous vote of its Board of Directors voluntarily surrendered to Patitioner, as Superintendent of Banks, all of the assets of said Bank, praying that same be applied by him to the purpose of liquidation, re-organization or such other or different action as shall be to the best interest of the depositors. Said Bank's assets are now in Petitioner's hands by virtue of said surrender. A copy of the resolution authorizing such surrender is hereto attached and marked "Exhibit A".

SECOND: Petitioner further shows that the Farmers State Bank of Loxley, Alabama, a Banking corporation recently organized with a paid up capital of \$15,000.00 and a paid in surplus of \$5,000 is now open for business in the town of Loxley and has made the Petitioner an offer to become liquidating agent for said Loxley State Bank, agreeing, as the consideration for the transfer to it all of the assets of the said Loxley State Bank to take over the Bank building and furniture at a price satisfactory to Petitioner and to pay all depositors of said Bank in full and to assume and pay all other proper and legitimate obligations thereof, to act as liquidating agent for said Loxley State Bank without compensation, collecting as far as possible all out standing accounts and assets, charging, therefor. only the actual and legitimate expenses, including counsel fees, as are approved by your Honorable Court. Said Bank further agrees that after repaying to itself all amounts expended in payment of the Loxley State Bank's obligations and the expenses of said liquidation, any balance coming into its hands from such assets will be divided proportionately among the stockholders of said Loxley State Bank. A copy of said offer is attached hereto and marked "Exhibit B".

THIRD: Petitioner further evers that in his official capacity he has become satisfied of the solvency and responsibility

of the Fermers State Bank and its ability to carry out the obligations as liquidating agent that it seeks to assume. He further shows that in his opinion the offer so made is a just and reasonable one, that it is to the interest of the depositors of said Loxley State Bank to accept said offer, and that by so doing Banking operations in the City of Loxley may continue without interruption, or delay.

Petitioner prays that due notice of this petition be given to the officers of the Loxley State Bank, that upon the hearing of this cause an order be made authorizing Petitioner to accept the offer of said Farmers State Bank, to execute proper instrument of transfer of the assets of said Loxley State Bank with proper provision made to carry out all of the terms of the expressed consideration, and that such other further or different orders may be made as are meet and proper to carry out the purpose of this petition or such further matters as may hereafter arise in this cause.

A celled meeting of the Directors of the Loxley State
Bank was held this day, E. D. Corte, President, presiding and the
following directors present, L. G. Bertolla, Carl L. Schlich, W. T.
Caneen, J. B. Randell and John A. Corte.

The meeting being called to order, reading of the minutes was dispensed with and the following resolution was offered and un-

"WHEREAS, the Superintendent of the Banks for the State of Alabama has heretofore reported that an examination of the condition of this Bank shows an impairment of capital which he has called upon the officials of the Bank to make good:

AND WHEREAS, it appears impracticable to levy an essessment for this purpose and unwise to continue to do business without a general rearrangement of the Banks affairs:

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that, the President and Cashier of this Bank are hereby authorized and instructed to turn over all of assets of this Bank to the State Superintendent of Banks for liquidation, re-organization or such action as may seem to him best for the interest of the depositors.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said surrender and transfer take place as of the close of Bank hours of this day."

No further business appearing the meeting adjourned.

Dear Sir:-

By authority of a resolution this day passed by the Board of Directors, the undersigned hereby presents the offer of the Fermers State Bank of Loxley to purchase from you the entire essets of the Loxley State Bank now in your bands, under the following conditions:

The Bank building and fixtures this Bank will take over at the orice of dollars agreed on by you as being ressonable after proper allowance for depreciation. The remainder of the assets, including all deposits and accounts of every kind, are to be transferred to this Bank as liquidating agent, to realize upon and apply the net proceeds, together with the price of the Bank building and fixtures toward the repayment to this Bank for payments made and assumed on the deposits and other liabilities of the Loxley State Bank other then for capital stock, which denusits and debts of the Loxley State Bank we will assume and agree to pay in full. We further agree to act as liquidating egent for the Loxley State Bank without compensation other then actual expenses and for costs and legal face incorred in the collection of such assets. After resegment to this Benk of the amounts assumed and paid out by it in behalf of the Loxley State Bank any balance, is to be prorated among the stockholders of the Loxley State Bank in proportion to their respective holdings.

Upon information by you that this proposition is accepted, we will join with you in the execution of proper instruments to put said proposition into effect and obligate this Bank to carry out the provisionsthereof.
