The State of Alabama, by its Solicitor, complains of Fred Calvert, whose name is to your informant otherwise unknown than as stated, that in said County and within twelve months before the commencement of this prosecution he did operate a motor vehicle on U. S. Highway 31, a highway of the State of Alabama, in Baldwin County, Alabama, without having conspicuously displayed on the front or rear of said motor vehicle a registration or distinguishing plate or tag duly prescribed and issued for said vehicle by the Alabama Public Service Commission under the provisions of Article 3, Chapter 3, Title 48, Code of Alabama of 1940, as amended, and without having conspicuously displayed on said motor vehicle a registration or distinguishing plate or identification tag duly prescribed and issued for such vehicle by the Alabama Public Service Commission on or before, to-wit, July 5, 1940, contrary to law and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
