Comes your Petitioner, Paul Milton Cazalas, and respectfully represents that he is now confined in the County Jail of Baldwin County, Alabama, under and commitment, charged with the offense of Burglary in the Second Degree; that said offense occurred on July 30, 1951, and he has been committed since August 21, 1951, having been arrested on August 20, 1951; and that he is not able to employ counsel to represent him, and that he desires to plead guilty to said offense in said Circuit Court before indictment under the provisions of Code of Alabama, 1940, Title 15, Section 260.

And Petitioner prays the Court to instruct and request and notify the Solicitor of the Twenty-Eighth Judicial Circuit of Alabama, to file an sworm verified charge in the manner and form prescribed by said section, describing said offense, as provided by law. And that Your Honor forthwith set same down for hearing and trial, not less than fifteen days from the date of arrest and not less than three days from date of the solicitor filing said charge; and that on said date of hearing, Your Honor hear and determine your Petitioner's plea of guilt, and fix your Petitioner's punishment and forthwith sentence your Petitioner to the penitentiary of the State of Alabama. And he prays for general relief.


