Barnes, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown than as stated, did operate upon Alabama Highway 3, a public highway in Baldwin County, Alabama, a motor vehicle, but not a motorcycle, equipped with less than two separate means of adequately applying the brakes to at least two wheels of said vehicle, contrary to law and

against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
