And we, and each of us, hereby waive all exemptions we may have to any
personal property under the Constitution and Laws of the State of Alabama as to
the collection of the penalty of this bond.

Witness our hands and seals this 13th day of February, 1952.

The condition of the above obligation is such that, whereas the above bound
Millard Blair was duly convicted in the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, on the
13th day of February, 1952, of the above stated offense, and has duly applied for
and obtained an appeal from said conviction and sentence to the Court of Appeals
for the State of Alabama, and the amount of his appeal bond has been duly and
legally fixed at said above stated sum.
