INDICTMENT

THE STATE OF ALABAMA
Baldwin County.

Circuit Court, Spring Session, 1952

1. The Grand Jury of said County charge that before the finding of this indictment and since July 9, 1945, Ernest Anderson, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, being the driver of a motor vehicle that was involved in an accident on Greeno Road, a public highway in Baldwin County, Alabama, resulting in the death of Doris Hall, and in the injury of James A. Trione, failed to give his name and address, or failed to render reasonable assistance to the said Doris Hall and James A. Trione, including transportation of or making arrangements for the transportation of the said Doris Hall or James A. Trione to a physician or hospital for medical treatment, it appearing that such treatment was necessary, against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.

2. The Grand Jury of said County charge that before the finding of this indictment and since July 9, 1945, Ernest Anderson, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, being the driver of a motor vehicle that was involved in an accident on Greeno Road, a public highway in Baldwin County, Alabama, resulting in the death of Doris Hall, and in the injury of James A. Trione, failed to give his name and address, or failed to render reasonable assistance to the said Doris Hall or James A. Trione,
