The Grand Jury of said County charge that before the finding of this indictment Thomas J. Jordan, Jr., whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, wile an agent or officer designated as secretary—treasurer of the Tensaw Hunting Glub, an unincorporated association of persons, did embezzle or fraudulently convert, or fraudulently secrete with intent to convert to his own use or to the use of another, money in about the amount of Six Hundred Dollars, the property of the members of the sail Tensaw River Hunting Club, which said money came into his possession by virtue of said agency or office,

against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
