THE STATE vs. MOSE SANDERS

The State of Alabama, by its Solicitor, complains of Mose Sanders

that

in said county and within twelve months before the commencement of this prosecution he did drive a motor vehicle upon U. S. Highway 31, a public highway, in Baldwin County, Alabama, carelessly and heedlessly in wilful or wanton disregard of the rights or safety of others, or without due caution and circumspection and at a speed or in a manner so as to endanger or be likely to endanger a person or property, against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.

2. The State of Alabama, by its Solicitor, complains of Mose Sanders that in said county and within twelve months before the commencement of this prosecution he did drive a motor vehicle on U. S. Highway 31, a public highway, in Baldwin County, Alabama, at a careless and imprudent speed greater than was reasonable and proper, having due regard to the traffic, surface and width of the highway and of other conditions then and there existing, or at a speed so as to endanger the life, limb, or property of a person, contrary to law and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
