The Grand Jury of said County further charge that before the finding of this indictment BEN KENDALL, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, did buy, receive, conceal, or aid in concealing, one watch of the value of, to-wit, fifty dollars, the personal property of Vincent Narmantos, knowing that it was stolen, or having reasonable grounds for believing it had been stolen, and not having the intent to restore it to the owner,

against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
