The Grand Jury of said County further charge that before the finding of this indictment JOHN McLENDON, alias JOHN JOSEPH, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, did receive, conceal, or aid in concealing, or buy two tires, of the value of, to-wit, one hundred forty dollars, the personal property of L. J. Early, knowing that they were stolen, or having reasonable grounds for believing that they had been stolen, and not having the intent to restore them to the owner,

against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
