The Grand Jury of said County further charge that before the finding of this indictment ED CROLEY, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, did buy, receive, conceal, or aid in concealing, two tires of the value of, to-wit, one hundred forty dollars, the personal property of L. J. Early, knowing that they were stolen, or having reasonable grounds for believing that they had been stolen, and not having the intent to restore them to the owner,

against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
