The Grand Jury of said County further charge that before the finding of this indictment JOHN LEE KING, alias JOHNNIE LEE KING, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, feloniously took and carried away from the storehouse of Joe Dickman one pair of boxing gloves, five pairs of trousers, and one pair of bathing trunks, of the value of, to-wit, thirty dollars, the personal property of Joe Dickman,

against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
