The Grand Jury of said County charge that before the finding of this indictment PAT BROCK, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, unlawfully drove a motor truck on U. S. Highway 31, a public highway, in Baldwin County, Alabama, outside the limits of any city or incorporated town at a speed of, to-wit, fifty-two miles per hour, the maximum speed prima facie lawful then and there being forty miles per hour, against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.

2. The Grand Jury of said County charge that before the finding of this indictment PAT BROCK, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, unlawfully drove a motor truck on U. S. Highway 31, a public highway, in Baldwin County, Alabama, at such speed, to-wit, fifty-two miles per hour, as to endanger the life, limb, or property of another person or persons,

against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
