2. The Grand Jury of said County further charge that before the finding of this indictment, HENDERSON COLLINS, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, unlawfully, but without malice or the intention to kill, killed Frank Joseph Thiery, Jr., by negligently driving a motor truck against an automobile in which the said Frank Joseph Thiery, Jr., was riding, in such a manner as to wreck the said automobile in which said Frank Joseph Thiery, Jr., was riding and thereby caused the death of said Frank Joseph Thiery, Jr.,

against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
